Pumpkin Patch Trolley rides again!

The Pumpkin Patch Trolley returns to the Seashore Trolley Museum this weekend!

Guests of all ages will be treated to antique trolley rides on a heritage railroad to the museum's very own socially distanced Pumpkin Patch, where all guests may select a pumpkin to take home. Back at the Visitor's Center, families can paint their pumpkins and participate in other COVID-safe family activities, including craft-in-a-bag, a cookie walk, photo scavenger hunt, and spending time checking out the museum's outdoor exhibits and displays. Lunch service this year will be available by Texas Grace Kitchen.

The museum is encouraging guests to come in costume! Prizes will be given out each day for "Best Costume" and "Best Mask."

Admission is \$14 for adults, \$12 for adults age 60+, \$11.50 for youth ages 6-16, \$7 for youth ages 3-5, and \$2 for youth under 3. All proceeds will benefit the Seashore Trolley Museum.

Tickets will go fast and guests are encouraged to purchase tickets in advance. The event will be held rain or shine, but tickets may be transferred to another event day.

Most of the proceeds will go to the Dempsey Center.
