*** Be a tourist.** This works whether or not you really are one.

Even if you live here or have visited here dozens of times, take the opportunity to look at the community through fresh eyes. Pick up a souvenir (the kids would love to wear a Kennebunkport T-shirt back to school!), drive past Walker's Point, visit the pier in Cape Porpoise.
