Chalk the Port this weekend!

What is this event?

Chalk the Port is a free, family-friendly event in the tradition of European 16th-century street painting. Nationally-acclaimed featured artists, local artists, and children transform the pavement of the Recreation Department parking lot into a canvas full of colorful masterpieces using chalk.

In addition to the incredible chalk artists Chalk the Port features live music, a family carnival, and, new this year, a craft fair.

Why the event was created?

Chalk the Port was first introduced in 2017 and quickly grew over the next two years. Due to the global pandemic, the event had to be paused in 2020 and 2021, but returned in 2022.

The Town of Kennebunkport is a unique place that combines simple architecture, exquisite experiences, and a tight-knit community. Chalk the Port was designed to not only bring the community

together but also to find a creative and fun way to help our Parks and Recreation Department. All proceeds go to the scholarship fund for kids and seniors.

Laudholm Nature Crafts Festival

A favorite with exhibitors and the people who love their work, this prestigious show will be held 10-4 Saturday and Sunday and boasts 130 vendors in a beautiful seaside setting. It's the largest single fundraiser for Laudholm Trust, in support of Wells Reserve.

New England's finest exhibitors, selected by jury, display their wares, with music and local food rounding out the 2-day festival. The Laudholm campus of the Wells Reserve is a picture-perfect spot for this gathering of outstanding artisans and craftspeople.

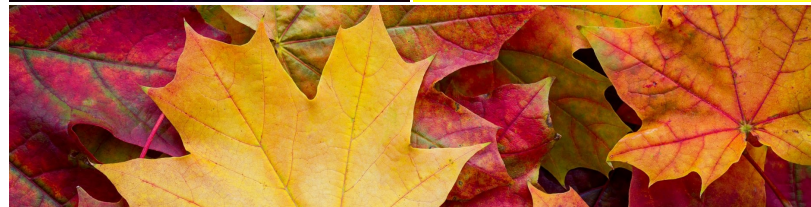
