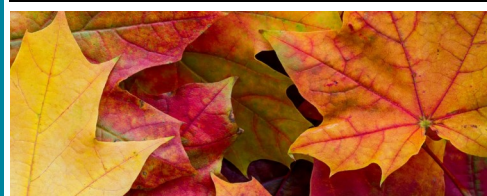

Discover the haunted history of Kennebunkport and neighboring Kennebunk on nightly ghost tours, offered at 7 p.m. nightly by American Ghost Tours. All tours begin at White Columns.

The ghost walk is guided by a local and accounts are authentic and documented in local history. Ghost stories from haunted hotels and inns abound. Tales feature roaming spirits, Spiritualist seances, and a poltergeist.

Glimpse the supernatural side of celebrities who summered in the Kennebunks, including Booth Tarkington and Margaret Deland. Fathom the seafaring yarns of haunted lighthouses, dire premonitions, ghost ships, sea serpents. Learn how Spiritualism research influenced area residents.
