



Discover the haunted history of Kennebunkport and neighboring Kennebunk on nightly ghost tours, offered at 7 p.m. nightly by American Ghost Tours. All tours begin at

White Columns. The ghost walk is guided by a local and accounts are authentic and documented in local history. Ghost stories from haunted hotels and inns

abound. Tales feature roaming spirits, Spiritualist seances, and a poltergeist.

Glimpse the supernatural side of celebrities who summered in the Kennebunks, including Booth Tarkington and Margaret Deland. "Step back in time as you pass by centuriesold buildings, once home to sea captains and prominent figures

whose spirits may linger in their former abodes. Listen carefully as we share lots of stories about the town coffin maker, notable figures and their tragic struggles back in 1812, the "rustling lady" known to scare guests, a captain's widow making her presence known, and more."

The 90-minute tour leads you through Kennebunkport's historic district and is \$29 a person.
