

This event has been re-imagined again this year to give families a pandemic-conscious experience. Most of the activities will take place outdoors and pumpkins will be physically distanced at



the pumpkin patch. A limited number of tickets is available for each ride time to ensure the event doesn't become crowded. Pumpkin Patch Trolley is the perfect fall event for families and friends of all ages to



enjoy! Board at our Visitors Center and take a trolley ride on our heritage railroad to The Pumpkin Patch. Each member in your group can select a pumpkin to take home, even the adults! Activities include:
